A Chapter A Day Through Books

A Good Church

Christian fellowship is vital to us all. We can't make it without good Christian friends and people who are more mature than us. God also wants to provide us with good spiritual leaders. However, finding them can be a real challenge.

Just because a building has a church name on the front and people get together to go through church services, doesn't make them a good congregation or a good church. Going to church is very important; but going to a GOOD church is even more important.

Good People

A good church must have good Christians who are REALLY living the Christian life. A good church must have good leaders who are teaching the truths of God's Word and applying them to their own life. A good church must be showing you how to establish a close and intimate relationship with God for yourself.

In other words, rather than just telling you what to believe and trying to tell you what the Bible means, they need to also be teaching you how to gradually start growing in your ability to receive training from Jesus on a personal level.

A Good Church

In other words, rather than just telling me what to believe and trying to tell me what the Bible means, they will also be teaching me how to gradually start growing in my ability to receive training from You on a personal level.

Worship

Since God wants a close, personal relationship with you, He wants you to learn how to start hearing directly from Him. One of those ways is for you to worship Him through songs. You need to go to a church that helps you worship God as you sing songs. This gives you a chance to see how others worship God. And it gives you the experience of worshiping God as a church group.

Worship Services

The times of singing songs during the service are called "worship services." They are opportunities of singing TO God rather than ABOUT God. If you listen to the words, some songs will lead you to say things to God. You will be singing the song directly to Him. Other songs will have words that seem to be talking to other people about Who God is and what He does. It is better to sing to God so you can open your heart to a love relationship with Him.

Worshipping God

There are songs that sing ABOUT God and seem to be trying to teach you more information. These songs are good for learning; however, this isn't a good time for you to be learning more information. That needs to be reserved for classes, sermons, and training times like what you are doing right now in these studies.

Praise, Thanksgiving, And Appreciation

Choruses that help you tell God how much you love Him and how much you appreciate His greatness are what you really need. If you can't find a church that provides this type of worship, then you need to buy some music that does. You need to spend a good portion of every day on your own and especially on Sunday with other Christians worshiping God in song.

Worship

Let that be reserved for classes, sermons, and training times like what I am doing right now in these studies.

Praise, Thanksgiving, And Appreciation

Jesus, empower me take advantage of choruses that help me tell God how much I love Him and how much I appreciate His greatness. If I can't find a church that provides this type of worship, then guide me in buying some music that does. Help me spend a good portion of every day on my own and especially on Sunday with other Christians worshiping God in song.

A Friendly Church

You need opportunities to start meeting the people in Jesus' Church. Whether the church you are trying out provides a time before, during, or after church, there needs to be a time when you can meet and visit with Jesus' people. You need to meet Christians of your own age, life situation, and spiritual level. The church needs to be made up of people who are friendly and willing to meet new people. They need to help you feel welcome and a part of the group.

Getting Acquainted

If you find yourself standing around by yourself, you MAY be at a church where new people aren't able to meet the people of the congregation. Talk to those who welcome you at the door; see if there is a special meeting you can attend where you can get acquainted with new people. There may be a time and a place where people get together to get acquainted. Also, there may be those who are willing to take you around and introduce you to some of the people of the church.

Join Special Groups

There may be special age group meetings that you can attend. The handout they give you at the door may tell about age group meetings, special bulletins may be posted in the entrance to the church building, and fliers may be laid around in certain places that tell about other church meetings. They may have a booth or table where helpful people stand to answer questions.

Give Them A Chance

You may need to fill out a card that gives some of your personal information. This may invite someone to call, text, or email you and chat with you about your experience at the church. This can give you a chance to ask questions and find out how to meet those of your own age. But, if it becomes too difficult getting in touch with the people in the church, you may need to keep searching. Just pray and ask God to guide you concerning how much effort you should put into trying to meet the people in that church.

A Christian Leader

You need to be around spiritual leaders who can provide you with sermons and teaching that will help you with your life. Christian Friends

You need a few people who are on the same basic spiritual level as you. They need to be willing to study with you, pray with you, and have fun with you. Good Christian Friends

Good Christian friends need to be people who will warn you and tell you what you need to hear even when you don't like hearing it. If they are people who will only tell you what you want to hear, then they aren't good friends. However, a GOOD Christian friend will be a person who will use the Bible to warn you. They won't be trying to run your life with their personal opinions; they will help you see where you are going wrong in your relationship with God and His Word.

Friends With A Good Influence

Your friends need to be people who are influencing you to a closer relationship with God. If you find them drawing you away from your times with God, His Word, and His people, then they are bad "friends" and they are probably a bad person. Just because someone has a good personality, is fun to be around, and has similar human interests doesn't mean they are a good friend. The most important quality in a friend is one who loves Jesus and follows His leadership.

Faithful Friends

A good Christian friend is one who is willing to point you toward God during times when you are starting to think, plan, and do things that are against Biblical training. If you find yourself getting more and more excited about God when you are around them, then they are good Christian friends. If you are going through a financial, emotional, relational, physical, or spiritual struggle, they will be willing to sacrifice their time and effort to be there helping you look to God and His Word.

Friends With Unsaved And New Christians

Share Your Breakthroughs

There are unsaved people and new Christians who are struggling in areas where you have been set free. When they get a chance to talk to you, they will get the hope and faith they need to start trusting God for their deliverance. If you simply open the conversation by telling about some wonderful thing that has happened to you, it will be a natural and normal type of conversation. Rather than always talking about unimportant things, you can ask them questions about how they are doing. Show an interest in those things they are going through that are hurting and causing stress in their lives. Helping Friends GET Interested In Christianity

As you go about your day, you meet people, talk to people, do business with people, and build relationships with people. Jesus wants us to use those contacts for spiritual purposes even more than for human purposes. If we are putting more emphasis on our human needs and interests, then we are cheating ourselves and those around us. You need to be helping a few people discover the wonderful benefits of Christianity. Some people will only see you once for a short moment. Others you will spend a lot of time with. Those who cross paths with you for a short moment, need a quick touch from Jesus. Those you will be able to build a relationship with can get a lot more from you.

The Quick Response

Jesus won't give you something to say to everyone you cross paths with. But, if you ask Him to help you know something about those people you are just meeting for a moment, He will give you special things to quickly drop into their lives. Jesus knows what every one of these people are going through. He may not tell you why you should say it; but, He will give you some spiritual statement to make to some casual acquaintance. You will have to KEEP asking Jesus to give you things to say and then ask Him to empower you to say them. The more you keep asking and LOOKING for His input, the more you will be used to help people who are just passing through your life.

Building A Spiritual Relationship

Those you want to build a spiritual relationship with must be people who are willing to allow you to talk to them about spiritual issues. As you are talking to them about spiritual things, you need to be aware of whether or not they are able to understand spiritual concepts. If they can't understand spiritual things or just want to be your friend and only talk about human and world subjects, then you need to move on to someone who will let you talk to them about the benefits of Christianity.

Preparing For Sharing

The most powerful way of getting ready for longer term spiritual relationships is for you to develop a list of all the wonderful things Jesus has done for you. If you not only use this list as a way to be thankful and appreciate God, you can start seeing ways of using these things in your conversation with others. As you become excited about these miracles, blessings, and breakthroughs, it helps you want to tell people about them. The more you add different things to your list, the more things you have to include in your conversations.

Sharing The Power Life

You can take the information found in "The Power Life" courses and go over it with those who want to join Jesus in Christianity. However, it is VERY important that you share how much Jesus has helped you, as you go through these courses. Your miracles and experiences with your heavenly Father are extremely important information. It lets your unsaved friends hear things you know for a fact are true.

Building A Spiritual Relationship

Jesus, those You give me the opportunity to build a spiritual relationship with, help them be people who are willing to allow me to talk to them about spiritual issues. As I am talking to them about spiritual things, help me be aware of whether or not they are able to understand spiritual concepts. If they can't understand spiritual things or just want to be my friend and only talk about human and world subjects, then help me know when to move on to someone who will let me talk to them about the benefits of Christianity.

A Christian Family

A good church should provide you with all of the opportunities of fellowship and friendship that we have discussed so far. But, if you need to find some of these people outside the church you have picked, then that is a good thing as well. You belong to a huge family of Christians all over the world. With the technology we have available, there are ways of having relationships through many sources. However, the most important thing is to be sure you have people you can sit down with and talk to face to face. You need Christian friends you can go do things together with.

Finding The Right Family Members

Since no church is perfect, you may need to associate with other Christians from other churches. Christianity isn't exclusive to one church or group. You should have one church that you feel meets most of your spiritual needs. But, you don't have to make it your only church. You don't shop at one store all the time. You probably have one store that you shop at most of the time. But, that doesn't mean you can't shop at other ones when the need arises.

Follow The Bible

The most important thing is for you to find the Christians that will help you grow and share the wonderful things of God.
