# Living The Christ-life Yield

# **SLIDE 1:**

John 15:1-14 (NIV) "I am the true vine, and My Father is the gardener. He cuts off every branch in Me that bears no fruit, while every branch that does bear fruit He prunes so that it will be even more fruitful. You are already clean because of the word I have spoken to you. REMAIN in Me, and I will REMAIN in you. No branch can bear fruit by itself; it must REMAIN in the vine. Neither can you bear fruit unless you REMAIN in Me. "I am the vine; you are the branches. If a man REMAINS in Me and I in him, he will bear much fruit; apart from Me you can do nothing.

If anyone does not REMAIN in Me, he is like a branch that is thrown away and withers; such branches are picked up, thrown into the fire and burned. If you REMAIN in Me and My words REMAIN in you, ask whatever you wish, and it will be given you. This is to My Father's glory, that you bear much fruit, showing yourselves to be My disciples. "As the Father has loved Me, so have I loved you.

Now <u>REMAIN in My love</u>. <u>If you obey My commands</u>, you will REMAIN in My love, just as I have <u>obeyed my Father's commands</u> and REMAIN in His love. I have told you this so that My joy may be in you and that your joy may be complete. <u>My command is this</u>: Love each other as I have loved you. Greater love has no one than this, that he <u>lay</u> down his life for his friends. You are my friends if you do what I command.

#### SLIDE 2:

I. John 15:1 I am the true <u>vine</u>, and My Father is the <u>gardener</u>. V. 5a I am the vine; you are the branches.

#### **SLIDE 3:**

II. V2. He CUTS OFF every branch in Me that bears <u>no fruit</u>, while every branch that does bear fruit He PRUNES so that it will be even more fruitful.

# **SLIDE 4:**

# Fruit Bearing Characteristics (Mat 5:3-6):

- **A. Poor in spirit:** A teachable attitude.
- **B. Mourn:** Feeling bad about the things we do to ourselves and others.
- **C. Meek:** Letting God take care of our problems and issues.
- **D.** Hunger and thirst for righteousness: Desire for God and the things of God.

# SLIDE 5:

III. V. 4b No branch can bear fruit by itself; it must REMAIN in the vine.

V.5b If a man REMAINS in Me and I in him, he will <u>bear much fruit</u>; <u>APART from Me you can do nothing</u>.

#### SLIDE 6:

- IV. NOW REMAIN IN MY LOVE (V. 9b): <u>If you obey My commands</u>, you will REMAIN in My love (V. 10a).
  - **A. The self-esteem person:** I have decided I am a good person.
  - **B.** The people-esteem person: My friends think I am a good person.
  - **C. The possession, position, or power esteem person:** My achievements prove I am a good person.

# **SLIDE 7:**

**D.** The God-esteem person: God considers me a good person.

# God-esteem is based on the value that God places on a person

- 1. God Loves Humans Because He Created Them Heb 2:6 (NIV) But there is a place where someone has testified: "What is man that You are mindful of him, the son of man that You care for him?
- 2. God Loves All Of Them Sacrificially John 3:16 (NIV) "For God so loved the world that He gave His one and only Son, that WHOEVER believes in Him shall not perish but have eternal life.
- 3. God Loves Each INDIVIDUAL Person
  Luke 15:7 (NIV) I tell you that in the same way there will be more rejoicing in
  heaven over ONE sinner who repents than over ninety-nine righteous persons
  who do not need to repent.

#### **SLIDE 8:**

- V. HOW TO OBEY JESUS' COMMANDS: PRAY Matthew 7:7-11
  - **A. Heart For Self** I know I am doing fine.
  - **B.** Heart For The World

**People** – My friends and mentors say I am a good person.

**Possessions** – My success proves my value.

**C. Heart For God** – God is making me into the person I want to be. God is making me into the person the people around me can like. In the meantime, He loves me just the way I am.

# SLIDE 9:

VI. JESUS CAN DO WHAT WE CANNOT DO: Yield to Him Gal 2:20 (NIV) I have been crucified with Christ and <u>I no longer live</u>, but Christ <u>lives in me</u>. The life I live in the body, I live by faith in the Son of God, Who loved me and gave Himself for me.

# **SLIDE 10:**

- VII. The Holy Spirit Provides Us With Three Aspects Of Jesus
  - 1. WE GET JESUS' LOVE:

Rom 5:5 (NIV) And hope does not disappoint us, because <u>God HAS poured out HIS LOVE</u> into our hearts by the Holy Spirit, Whom He has given us.

# 2. WE GET JESUS' TRUTH:

John 16:13-14 (NIV) But when He, the Spirit of truth, comes, <u>He WILL guide you into ALL truth</u>. He will not speak on His own; He will speak only what He hears, and He will tell you what is yet to come. He will bring glory to Me by taking from what is Mine and making it known to you.

# 3. WE GET JESUS' LIFE:

Gal 5:22-23 (NIV) But the <u>fruit of the Spirit</u> is love, joy, peace, patience, kindness, goodness, faithfulness, gentleness and self-control. Against such things there is no law.
