The Twenty-Five Truths Of Romans Chapter Seven

These are the twenty-five truths Jesus teaches you in your study in the **Victorious Christian Living** book. This is a good review for you to go over, while you are on your journey, as a new and untrained Christian. It is also a good tool for helping a friend make their journey from their Romans-chapter-seven life into their Romans-chapter-eight life. Jesus can use the studies and prayers in the next book, **Committing To The Christian Life**, to help you and your friend accomplish this goal.

How To Be Free Of A Law

TRUTH ONE: Once you die, the law no longer has any influence or jurisdiction over you. Rom 7:1 (NIV) Do you not know, brothers--for I am speaking to men who know the law-that the law has authority over a man only as long as he lives?

How To Be Free Of A Marriage Law

TRUTH TWO: The marriage contract is no longer in effect, once the other spouse dies. Rom 7:2 (NIV) For example, by law a married woman is bound to her husband as long as he is alive, but if her husband dies, she is released from the law of marriage.

How To Live Free Of A Law

TRUTH THREE: The marriage contract law is still in effect as long as both spouses are alive. Rom 7:3 (NIV) So then, if she marries another man while her husband is still alive, she is called an adulteress. But if her husband dies, she is released from that law and is not an adulteress, even though she marries another man.

How You Became Free Of A Law

TRUTH FOUR: You died to the law by accepting Jesus' death as your death through faith. Rom 7:4 (NIV) So, my brothers, you also died to the law through the body of Christ, that you might belong to another, to Him Who was raised from the dead, in order that we might bear fruit to God.

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The Law Used For Evil

TRUTH FIVE: As an unsaved person, you were controlled by the **sinful nature** in your body. Its **passions** were illegal according to the law of sin and death in the Old Testament. And, you yielded to those passions and died spiritually and were separated from God. **Rom 7:5 (NIV)**For when we were controlled by the sinful nature, the sinful passions aroused by the law were at work in our bodies, so that we bore fruit for death.

Free From One Law Into Another Law

TRUTH SIX: By dying through accepting Jesus' death as your death to what once bound you, which was the law of sin and death in the Old Testament, you have been released from the law so that you serve in the new way of the Spirit, which is the law of the Spirit of life in the New Testament. Rom 7:6 (NIV) But now, by dying to what once bound us, we have been released from the law so that we serve in the new way of the Spirit, and not in the old way of the written code.

What God's Law Is Not

TRUTH SEVEN: The law of sin and death in the Old Testament is not sin. Rom 7:7 (NIV) What shall we say, then? <u>Is the law sin? Certainly not!</u> Indeed I would not have known what sin was except through the law. For I would not have known what coveting really was if the law had not said, "Do not covet."

When Law Doesn't Exist

TRUTH EIGHT: If there is no law, then you can't break it. Rom 7:8 (NIV) But sin, seizing the opportunity afforded by the commandment, produced in me every kind of covetous desire. For apart from law, sin is dead.

Your Conscience Became Your Law

TRUTH NINE: When the commandment came: When you became old enough to be responsible for knowing the difference between right and wrong, good and bad, and righteousness and evil, God caused your conscience to become active. Sin sprang to life and I died: When that happened, you sinned and became separated from God. Rom 7:9 (NIV) Once I was alive apart from law; but when the commandment came, sin sprang to life and I died.

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Your Conscience Lacks Power

TRUTH TEN: The very commandment that was intended to bring life: The law of sin and death was to point out what was spiritually deadly so you would avoid it, thus keeping you alive in your relationship with God. Actually brought death: But, because of the sinful nature in your body, you were pushed into a life of sin (you broke the law) and death (you were separated from God). Rom 7:10 (NIV) I found that the very commandment that was intended to bring life actually brought death.

Satan Deceived You

TRUTH ELEVEN: Sin, seizing the opportunity: As an unsaved person, Satan tempted you to do things against God's law like he did with Adam and Eve. Deceived me: Satan made things look good that he was tempting you with. And through the commandment: Since the Holy Spirit was speaking to your conscience and telling you sin is wrong, you knew what God's commandment was. When you did it anyway, you knowledgeably sinned on purpose and it put you to death. Rom 7:11 (NIV) For sin, seizing the opportunity afforded by the commandment, deceived me, and through the commandment put me to death.

God's Law Is Good

TRUTH TWELVE: The law of sin and death in the Old Testament is telling you the truth about those things it labels sins. Therefore, when it tells you not to do something, it is giving you a holy, righteous and good command. Rom 7:12 (NIV) So then, the law is holy, and the commandment is holy, righteous and good.

God's Law Serves An Important Purpose

TRUTH THIRTEEN: Recognized as sin: You had to know what was destroying your life; sin was killing you. So, you needed to avoid it. It produced death: It was good that the law showed you what was killing you, but it made you responsible. Sin might become utterly sinful: Satan was deceiving you by making sin look good; but, God's law told you the truth about sin. Rom 7:13 (NIV) Did that which is good, then, become death to me? By no means! But in order that sin might be recognized as sin, it produced death in me through what was good, so that through the commandment sin might become utterly sinful.

God's Law Lacks Power

TRUTH FOURTEEN: The law is spiritual: It is how the spirit realm works. I am unspiritual: You only know how the natural, human world works. Sold as a slave to sin: God's law is teaching you the truth; but, that's all it can do. It can't keep Satan, your body, and the world from pushing you into sin. Rom 7:14 (NIV) We know that the law is spiritual; but I am unspiritual, sold as a slave to sin.

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You Lack Power

TRUTH FIFTEEN: Just like the law of sin and death doesn't have the power to force or help you do what it is making clear to you, even though you see how right it is, you can't force or help yourself live it. Rom 7:15 (NIV) I do not understand what I do. For what I want to do I do not do, but what I hate I do.

Your Want Is Important

TRUTH SIXTEEN: Since you can see that the law of sin and death is **good**, even though you don't have the power to obey it, you are still a true Christian. Rom 7:16 (NIV) And <u>if I do</u> what I do not want to do, <u>I agree</u> that the law is good.

You Have A Perfect Record With God

TRUTH SEVENTEEN: The moment you became a true Christian, God gave you a perfect record with Him, so that when *your body* does wrong, bad, or evil things, He doesn't hold it against you. He considers it a sin that was committed by your body. Rom 7:17 (NIV) As it is, it is no longer I myself who do it, but it is sin living in me. This is talking about the sinful nature that is inside your body.

The Sinful Nature Is More Powerful Than You

TRUTH EIGHTEEN: I know that nothing good lives in me, that is, in my sinful nature: The sinful nature is in your body and that makes nothing good living in the body part of you. For I have the desire to do what is good: The spirit part of you wants to do good and hates doing anything bad. But I cannot carry it out: Your human effort and world training does not work in Christianity. You need Jesus to help you carry it out. Rom 7:18 (NIV) I know that nothing good lives in me, that is, in my sinful nature. For I have the desire to do what is good, but I cannot carry it out.

The Sinful Nature Is More Powerful Than Your Want

TRUTH NINETEEN: For what I do: As a new or untrained Christian, most of what you were taught was human effort. So, you ended up continuing to do wrong, bad, and even evil to yourself, other people, and God's plan. For what I do is not the good I want to do: Because you are a true Christian, you want to do good. The evil I do not want to do-this I keep on doing: Because you haven't been trained and know how to yield to the power of the Holy Spirit, you keep doing things you hate. Rom 7:19 (NIV) For what I do is not the good I want to do; no, the evil I do not want to do-this I keep on doing.

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You Are No Longer Your Deeds

TRUTH TWENTY: Now if I do what I do not want to do: This "if" brings you into the law of the Spirit of life in the New Testament. This verse is how you can know you are a true Christian. It is no longer I who do it: This is your perfect record with God. He considers it to no longer be you doing those things that are wrong, bad, or evil. He attributes it to the enslavement put on you by your body. But it is sin living in me that does it: The evaluation of God is putting the blame on the sinful nature of your body. Rom 7:20 (NIV) Now if I do what I do not want to do, it is no longer I who do it, but it is sin living in me that does it.

This Is The Law Of Your Body

TRUTH TWENTY-ONE: **So I find this law at work:** This is the law that governs the new and untrained Christian. It is a temporary law that will soon be rescinded. **When I want to do good:** Keep in mind, this is the attitude and desire of the true Christian. **Evil is right there with me:** You are living in your body that has the **sinful nature.** You have to fulfill the activities of your day through your body that has this evil resident in it. **Rom 7:21 (NIV) So I find this law at work:** When I want to do good, evil is right there with me. The sinful nature is right there resident in your body.

This Is How You Feel

TRUTH TWENTY-TWO: In my inner being: This is you, a spirit being. I delight in God's law: Because you, a spirit being, are a true Christian, this is how you feel about the law of sin and death in the Old Testament. You see the importance that through the commandment sin might become utterly sinful. You agree that the law is holy, and the commandment is holy, righteous and good. That is why you delight in God's law. Rom 7:22 (NIV) For in my inner being I delight in God's law.

This Is What You Are Dealing With

TRUTH TWENTY-THREE: But I see another law at work in the members of my body: There is a body law. Waging war against the law of my mind: The law in your mind is the law of the Spirit of life. The law of your body is waging war against the law of your mind. The law of your body is making you a prisoner of the law of sin at work within your members. Rom 7:23 (NIV) But I see another law at work in the members of my body, waging war against the law of my mind and making me a prisoner of the law of sin at work within my members.

Truth Twenty-Three is why Romans 7:15 is happening to you: I do not understand what I do. For what I want to do I do not do, but what I hate I do. It is why it is no longer I who do it.

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You Realized That You Needed Outside Help

TRUTH TWENTY-FOUR: What a wretched man I am: As Jesus explained verses fifteen on down to here, He was telling you that, as a new or untrained Christian, you were trying to live the Christian life using human effort and world training. You, like every other Christian, found out that it doesn't work in Christianity. So, at this point, you see your need to cry out for outside help. Who will rescue me from this body of death: This is just a question; it isn't yet an ask-prayer that is asking for help. It is just asking, Who will rescue me? Rom 7:24 (NIV) What a wretched man I am! Who will rescue me from this body of death?

You Discovered That Jesus Could Help You

TRUTH TWENTY-FIVE: **Thanks be to God:** This is your first step into **the law of the Spirit of life.** You had to learn the truth of twenty-four, that you needed outside help. But, it was eternally vital that you learn it. **Who** was going to **rescue** you **from this body of death? Through Jesus Christ our Lord!** So, once you prayed The Lord's Prayer or some "sinner's prayer," you then did what Romans 10:8-10 told you to do; and, you were saved and justified. But, that was when you started your Romans 7:15-25 journey of trying to get human effort and world training to help you live the Christian life.

So then, I myself in my mind am a slave to God's law, but in the sinful nature a slave to the law of sin. I myself: You are now aware that you are a spirit being with a mind inside you that is a slave to God's law. You are also aware that your body has a sinful nature in it that is a slave to the law of sin. Jesus will use Romans chapter eight to help you solve this problem. Rom 7:25 (NIV) Thanks be to God--through Jesus Christ our Lord! So then, I myself in my mind am a slave to God's law, but in the sinful nature a slave to the law of sin.

Conclusion

This is a good review, as you move on in your Christian life. Jesus can help you use it to resist human effort and world training. It can show you, when you are starting to slip back into reliance on yourself rather that *asking*, *seeking*, and *knocking* through Jesus. This is also a good tool to share with those new and untrained Christians who haven't learned these principles. However, the better pamphlet to use in those cases is, **How Does Christianity Work According To Romans Chapter Seven**. It's the same basic study; but, with different starting and concluding words.

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
